In the pheresis procedure, said Dr. Shaler, blood is drawn from one arm and passed through a blood separating instrument that separates and collects a single blood component such as plasma, platelets or white cells.

The remaining blood components, including the reducells, are returned to

arm. The body normally replaces the component drawn in pheresis within 24 hours.

Pheresis therapy is used to treat partients undergoing cancer therapy or other diseases which respond to this type of medical therapy.

A platelet transfusion for one patients would require sit to elight donations of whole blood and that white cells are extremely difficult to extract from a whole blood donation.
