

Bob Fezzey retires from Michigan Bell

Robert W. Fezzey of Farmington Hills will retire from Michigan Bell Dec. 11, ending a 35-year career with the telephone company.

Fezzey, 59, has been assistant vice president for public affairs with Michigan Bell since 1959. A Detroit native, Fezzey joined the company as a salesman in Detroit in 1945 after attending Albion College for two years and completing a three-year tour of duty with the U.S. Air Force in the Pacific Theater during World War II.

Early in his career, he held several management positions in Michigan Bell's telephone directory and commercial operations in Detroit and Grand Rapids.

Fezzey was named public relations manager in Detroit in 1960 and the following year was selected to attend William College's Institute of American Studies for Executives in Williams-town, Mass.

In 1963, he was appointed public relations executive assistant in Detroit and remained in that job until he was promoted to his present position.

Stock buying workers have tax refund due

Employees who participate in company stock purchase and savings plans may be entitled to interest payments on previously obtained tax refunds as the result of an accountant's appeal of a state tax ruling.

The refunds, which may be due tax-

payers who filed state forms MI 1040-X, could date retroactively for three years. Recent state legislation "stabilized" Sept. 16, 1980 will change the rules for future interest refunds.

Federal tax refunds have long included retroactive interest payments.

The change in state tax policy followed an appeal by Jack Downie, a Farmington accountant who received complaints from clients.

Interest is due at a 9 percent annual rate, retroactive three years.

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
