

Michigan has more than 60 Christmas tree farms, giving cut-it-yourselfers more than 600,000 evergreens and more than a dozen varieties from which to choose.

Prices start at \$3 for Scotch pines to \$30 for blue spruce and \$25 for Douglas fir. Eight farms sell trees by the foot, varying from \$1.25 to \$3, depending on the variety.

Sizes can range from foot-tall, transplantable - potted trees to shaped, room-size Austrian, French and Japanese pines and the white pine, Michigan's state tree.

At many farms, children can see, feed or pet everything from ducks and hogs to horses, and enjoy free treats like popcorn balls and hot cider. Some farms' even feature visits by Santa Claus.

Nearly half the farms will wrap branches with twine for easy transport while some will mechanically clean trees of dead needles and other debris.

If planning a tip to a choose-and-cut farm this season, AAA suggests these tips:

- Take a hand saw. Most farms lend saws but they could be in use, especially on weekends. Axes are banned.
- When choosing, remember that most pines and Douglas firs hold needles, and spruces and balsams shed quickly if not cared for properly.
- After deciding on a tree, saw the trunk close to the ground.
- Although most farms have twine to tie the trees to cars, take rope just in case. Tie the tree's base at the front of the car.
- Store trees in a bucket of water in a cool area. Before placing in a stand, diagonally cut an inch or two off the base to help the tree absorb water. Fill the stand with water daily.
- Avoid placing trees near heating ducts or open flames.
- Before decorating, always check tree lights for bare wires and make sure electrical outlets won't be overloaded.
