The smaller \$5 size gives you two types of tea, orange marmalade, grape jelly and strawberry preserves. They're both at the Bon Ton Shop.

• IF YOU'D RATHER give clothing, Hadley's carries a SoxBox, \$7.99 worth of knee-high woolies to warm your beloved's toes. They also carry an assortment of gloves, hats and scarves at prices hovering around \$9.

Slippers to slide into on those winter mornings are available at such stores as Pay-Less Shoes and Scott's Five and Dime for prices beginning at \$3.97. They range from soft, foam-filled mules to those quilted boots which look like they'd keep Nanuck of the North warm.
