CLASSES INCLUDE proper warm-up and conditioning, balance beam, vaulting, uneven parallel bars, floor exercise, tumbling and dance.
Tots begin with a program designed as a basic movement education class with emphasis on gymnastic skills. This aids the child in developing an awareness of self, hand and eye coordination, a sense of balance and strength.
