GARVER, WHO served as Walled Lake superintendent from 1965 to 1970 when the bond issue was proposed and approved, said he believed the charges to be "totally faske, inappropriate and truly injurious to the reputation of a dedicated and competent member of your administrative staff."

Garver said the school board had been authorized by the State Depart-ment of Education at the time the bond issue was approved to utilize earned in-terest from the \$9.5 million bond issue "as a hedge against inflation and for other projects that might be approved at a later date by the board of educa-tion and the department of education."
