"I'm happy because she's my sister," says Tiffany, bugging her friend Anna and then teasing her.

"See, she's the only one in her family," Anna explains. "There's no sisters or brothers so I'm like a sister to her." Joey and Donny live together in a group home, performed together in the play and are almost inseparable at school, according to Mrs. Aaron. She says the two have almost a telepathy between them and teachers are trying to get them to communicate well with others.

THEY COMMUNICATED with the audience Thursday afternoon just fine.

And nobody was prouder than Mrs. Aaron. She explained the idea behind doing drama with the retarded.

"First of all it encourages interaction in a group, which is so important," she said. "When these kids finish a show they become like club members. They respond to each other. When one gets out of hand, they keep each other in line."

"It gives them self-esteem. Their parents sit out in the audience, their friends see them up there. These are kids who get so few hurrahs."

The students like Tiffany and Joe who can speak well are still taught sign language to allow them to communicate with the deaf students.
