These include Teflon, TFE,

FEP, Kynar, Kel-F, Nylon and Teflon-S. There are just a few firms in the entire United States with a diversified custom application like Sun Plastic.

THE COMPANY HAS DONE work for the entire spectrum of American industry including aero-space, aviation, automotive and medicine.

"We're not in business just to make money, but to generate and pioneer," says Tate. The company's record of accomplishment bears out this philosophy.

For instance, Sun Plastic Teflon coated a heart machine because a slick surface with anti-corrosive properties was needed. The machine's job is to replace the function of a heart during heart or cardio vascular surgery.

Most all of the mechanical parts in the engine and drive system, including propellers, of a 150 class hydroplane were coated with Teflon and the boat became winner of the Detroit River Regatta.

Every nut, bolt and piece that

went into a machine for an auto company was Teflon coated to provide anti-stick. Pistons used in an air chamber were similarly coated to avoid sticking.

Sun Plastic also has solved problems in jet engines, in commercial dryers, valves for dams and tire molds. The company's service is truly unique. The company has built on service and quality in an area of exotic coatings that require experience and art to apply. Its own success is proof that new frontiers in industrial-plastics still exist.

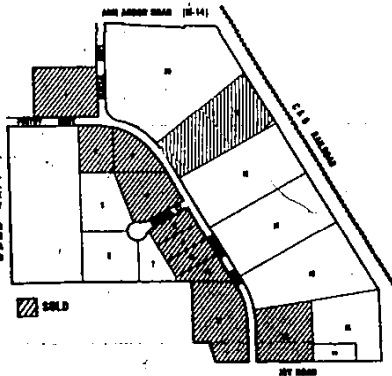
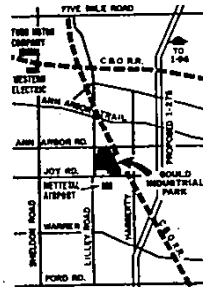

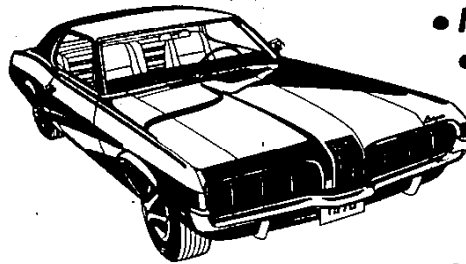
