Four area residents comprise the cast of "Relatively Speaking." Alan Ayckbourn's satire of British middle-class life.

Appearing in the cast are Danny Hicks of Southfield as Greg, Mary Whiting of Rochester as Ginny, and Ralph Rosati of Farmington Hills and Sandra Sutherland of Southfield as the parents.

The story centers around two couples and some intriguing mistaken identities. Greg and Ginny are young lovers planning to marry, but before they do Ginny insists she must see her parents.

Actually, she is off to tell her former employer and lover they are finished. Greg beats her to the "parents' ad-

dress and "father" becomes trapped between "mother" and "daughter." All the while, "father" struggles to save face and sanity.

## 'Jeririgg' chosen for festival

The Oakland University Mime Ensemble production of "Jeririgg" has been chosen to open the American College Theatre Festival on March 30 in Washington, D.C., and to take a summer USO-sponsored tour of Europe.

Both awards are firsts for OU student productions. "Jeririgg" was selected to perform in the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts following a

regional ACTF festival appearance this January in Akron, Ohio.

"Jeririgg" is the creation of Tom Ashton, OU Student Enterprise Theatre director. It is a play on words in mime and based on American idiomatic sayings.

The Washington, D.C., performances will be in the evening March 30 and a matinee and evening show March 31.

THIS SUMMER, the Mime Ensemble will take "Jeririgg" to Europe between May 19 and July 11, spending most of that time on the continent and the final week in Iceland.

Because of the festival and European tour, spring and summer productions of "And They Dance Real Slow in Jackson" (April 3-12) and "Hair" (July 5-21) have been canceled.
