LIKEWISE, doomsday predictions about Detroit's impending demise are rebuffed by Blond.
"I believe this city will survive if we stick with it. If everybody packs up and leaves, we're in sad shape."

The year 1947 was when Blond came to Detroit as a correspondent for an Athens newspaper. His assignment was

to write about the Greek community in Detroit. During his stay, he met his wife, Helen, and decided to quit newspapering and remain in Detroit.

"At that time I didn't speak the language," Blond says. "So, naturally, what I was doing (news writing), I couldn't do here. I went to work in places where language wasn't necessary."

Blond found jobs in various restaurants, starting out washing dishes and doing short-order jobs. He and his wife were already raising a son, Peter, and

a daughter, Vickie, by 1956 when he opened his restaurant with his brother, Steve, who moved to the United States that year.

LIKE MANY immigrants, Blond is a staunch supporter of America. He said it hurt him to be on campus when many young people, including his son, were criticizing American involvement in Vietnam.

"The opportunities this country can

provide its citizens is unmatched anywhere," Blond said. "Unfortunately, people take America for granted. We should take young people who don't like this country over there. Not to visit. But to live there."

"They'll come back model citizens. That's the truth."

The angry indignation of our nation's youth can be a positive thing, though, Blond says, if it becomes part of their experience.
