

Contemporary Look Enlivens Oakland U.

ROCHESTER
Thirty-seven undergraduate courses will be offered at Oakland University June 23-Aug. 11, according to Lewis N. Pino, dean of the summer school. Spiced with a strong contemporary flavor, offerings include a course on black literature, one on modern China, and, for the budget-conscious, an analysis of pricing, research allocation and income

distribution broken down to the family unit level.
Pino said the courses should be of particular interest to university students resident in the area during the summer and to community college graduates. Non-OU students

wishing to take courses should apply through the director of admissions.

In addition to the undergraduate offerings, 12 graduate level courses will be given during the June 23-Aug. 11 summer session, Pino said. Undergraduate courses follow.

University courses—western literature; introduction to art; introduction to music; introduction to American politics; introduction to social psychology; introduction to economics; introduction to sociology;

introduction to China; environment and man.
Social sciences—man in culture and society; microeconomic analysis; urban-regional economics; management systems analysis; U.S. foreign policy; foundations of contemporary psychology; child development; character and social structure; sociology of crime and punishment; social change.


Humanities—Shakespeare; black literature; master works of Spanish literature in English translation; modern American poetry; elementary reading in French; introduction to European history; introduction to American history; introduction to Russian history; the age of the American revolution 1760-1790; U.S. diplomatic history; early modern Europe; the nature of language; survey of Russian literature.

Science and mathematics—elementary functions; structure of number systems; introductory organic chemistry; introductory organic chemistry laboratory; modern astronomy.
