

Haitians seek new life

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"And now they're taking a chance with their lives getting on all kinds of boats to get to Florida," Civilus said.

An estimated 40,000 Haitians are in Florida today. The Michigan Haitian Association is well aware of their plight.

Last month, with the help of UAW Vice President Marc Stepp, they were able to gather and transport 40,000 pounds of shoes, shirts, pants, baby clothes, canned food, and even a 35-pound drum of candy to the Krome North Haitian refugee camp.

The Haitians gathered the merchandise, but Stepp helped get the materials transported to the camp. Many gifts on the Miami-bound truck were contributed by Chrysler workers, some laid off from their jobs.

BOTH EMMANUELS, Bolivar and Civilus said they love this country.

But the lovely island with the constant sea breeze and childhood memories seems to have a definite hold on each of them.

Bolivar speaks proudly of his country: "Haiti was the first black republic. It was the second state in this hemisphere to be independent. Before that, it was occupied by the British, Spanish and French, who all fought over it."

"Christopher Columbus came to Haiti in 1492. It was the third spot in the new world where he stepped his foot. He was amazed by its beauty and called it 'Hispaniola' or 'Little Spain.' On Oct. 17, 1806, the hero of Haitian independence was assassinated. Since then, civil revolutions have shaken the country repeatedly.

"Twenty-seven dictatorships have come and gone. Political instability is chronic in Haiti."

Civilus and Bolivar and the members of their organization plan other aid to the encamped refugees. They have incorporated as a non-profit organization in order to raise money to help the hungry, unemployed and unclothed.

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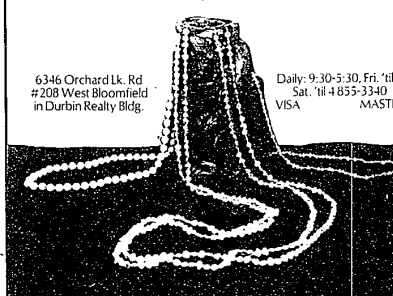
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
