The teen-ager, described by those who knew him as hard working and friendly, had been active in athletics since an early age. He had passed a general physical exam prior to participating in sports at Central as all athletes are required to do, school officials said.

Lampe, who enjoyed fishing and camping, was a member of Boy Secut Troop 160. Members of his troop served as honorary pallbearers at the funeral as did members of the Central track team.

Athletic Director Tom Evans, who said he did not know Lampe personally, said that the boy's death was a "terrible thing. I feel so much for his family and friends, it's such a tragedy."




