

## Red Cross honors Hills volunteers

Two Farmington Hills residents were among 43 American Red Cross volunteers honored for 25 years, or more of service recently. Water Safety Instructors Jewell Cooks and Lois Biers received 25-year awards at the Southeastern Michigan Chapter Centennial/Recognition Celebration.

The program held at the Michigan State Fairgrounds' Community Arts Building\* recognized approximately 2,000 staff and volunteers, and celebrated the 100th anniversary of the American Red Cross.

Cooks began assisting with Red Cross water safety programs in 1922 and later became certified as an instructor. She currently teaches for the Livonia and West Bloomfield Adult Education and Parks and Recreation departments.

Biers first taught water safety at a Girl Scout camp in Cayuga Lake, N.Y. Since then, she's instructed a number of swimming and first aid classes, and continues teaching in her current position with the YWCA in northwest Detroit.

## Hors d'oeuvres class Thursday

"Easy and elegant" is the way talented cook Judy Antishin describes the "Hors D'Oeuvres Workshop" she's bringing back to Farmington Community Center on Thursday, May 14.

Mrs. Antishin will demonstrate an intriguing assortment of her newly-adapted recipes for guests to taste, who will also take home complete-printed instructions.

Many of her dishes are southern-inspired recipes brought back from her yearly visits to Tennessee and Kentucky. She comments that "they always have a definite personality of their own." She adds that she'll be demonstrating new ways to use fruit on the hors d'oeuvres table. One recipe pairs hot fruit, cointreau and whipping cream. Another shows how a hollowed-out pineapple serves as a base for a tangy hot sauce teamed with bacon to use as a spread.

"There's also a surprise bite-sized pastry I'll be filling with meat," says Mrs. Antishin, "but I'm keeping it secret until the 14th."

The one-session workshop is 47 per person and will be given in the evening from 7:30 p.m. at 24705 Farmington Road.
