

Muer's P'Jazz kicks off 10th anniversary year

Forty-five years of big band history come to the poolside terrace at the Hotel Pontchartrain when Woody Herman and his Thundering Herd opens the 10th anniversary season of Chuck Muer's P'Jazz at 8 p.m. Wednesday.

It's Herman's seventh appearance on the series at the downtown Detroit hotel.

"Woody Herman's band is always a favorite — a tradition at P'Jazz," said Chuck Muer. "Woody's a personable guy and he loves the atmosphere here and the people, and the people love Woody."

Herman mingles with the informal, numbertime crowds at P'Jazz, chatting with the reserved-seat patrons and the general admission crowd who stand. People listen to the music while snacking on hamburgers and kielbasa, sipping cocktails and soft drinks.

Big band concerts offered on cruise

Bob-Lo Island's weekly "Big Band" concert series has returned for its third season, offering the Detroit area's only floating dance floor.

"Sailing on the boat while listening to great music is an experience only Bob-Lo can offer," said Richard J. Langlais, chief executive officer of Bob-Lo. Lighted parking is available at a Detroit municipal lot at 229 Third Avenue, adjacent to the Detroit River.

Carillon, chorus open music series

Carillon music, a choral concert and an old-fashioned ice cream social will herald Christ Church Cranbrook's summer music series beginning June 28 in Bloomfield Hills.

Bok Singing Tower (Florida) carillonneur Milford Myhre will begin the program at 4 p.m. with an hour-long concert comprising varied hymns and classical pieces.

Featured will be Handel's "Allegro" and "Entrance of the Queen of Sheba," Appleby's "Suite for Carillon" and selections from Mozart's "The Magic Flute."

Myhre is a carillon teacher, lecturer, composer and recorder. He studied at the University of Michigan and the Royal Carillon School in Mechelen, Belgium.

THE CARILLON is best heard 200 feet from the church. Visitors may listen to the carillon recital on the lawn on their cars.

Immediately following at 5 p.m. the Grunyons, a 17-member Detroit businessmen's group, will perform a concert in Christ Church Guild Hall.

Their program, comprising old favorites mixed with current popular tunes, will include "Blue Skies," "My Romance," "Easy to Love" and "Sweet Georgia Brown."

Founded in 1949 by several members of Yale University's famed Wiffenpoofs, the Grunyons have performed throughout Michigan and the U.S., including Orchestra Hall, the Library of Congress, Colorado's governor mansion and at the Republican National Convention.

BOTH CONCERTS are open to the public without charge. An ice cream extravaganza in the Christ Church lower dining hall follows the concerts.

Herman is credited by many jazz experts for keeping an open mind on new talent and updated arrangements. His band tours 45 weeks of the year.

The Los Angeles Times called Herman's Herd a prime example of a big band "transcending the age of the singers, the age of bebop, and even these years of rock, rearing and extending the big band idea: inspired improvisation within inspired arrangements."

Not only newer sounds will be offered at Wednesday's concerts but standards such as "Woodchopper's Ball" and "Caldonia" that have made Herman and his Herd an enduring favorite.
