

Registration June 24-26

District revs up for summer session

Farmington Public Schools' summer school program will begin on Monday, June 15.

High school classes will be taught Monday through Thursday at Harrison High School, 22955 12 Mile, through Thursday, Aug. 13.

Tuition is \$45 a class and must be paid during registration June 24-26 at Harrison from 8:30 a.m. to noon and 1-5:30 p.m. Refunds must be requested prior to Thursday, July 2. There is a \$2 non-refundable registration fee.

Classes offered include general math 1, algebra, geometry, refresher math, basic computers, reading improvement, grammar, English 9, 10, 11 and 12, reading improvement, essay writing, ecology, and psychology.

Also offered are typing, office skills, government, ancient history, Civil War and Reform, United States as a world power, modern European history.

INDIVIDUALIZED LEARNING programs will be available to students in grades two through six. This program provides opportunities for enrichment in reading, spelling, language, creative writing and math.

Students are tested and a personal program is developed to meet the needs of the child. Activities will take place at Middlebelt School, 24400 Middlebelt Road.

Classes meet from 7:50-8:50 a.m., 9-10 a.m., 10:10-11:10 a.m. and 11:20 a.m. to 12:20 p.m. Students electing the 10-10 reading-class hour will have an opportunity for special tutoring from Michigan State University personnel.

Registrations for grades two through eight will be at Middlebelt School from 8 a.m. to noon and 1-5 p.m. on June 24-26. Classes cost \$25. Seventh- and

eighth-graders can choose from math, science, reading and social studies.

Other special programs will be offered during summer school. These include fine arts — students can select classes in instrumental or voice music, dance, orchestra or theatre.

The fine-art program will be at East Middle School, 25000 Middlebelt. Classes will begin on June 29. A single fee of \$30 allows the student to select as many different classes as desired. Registration will be on the first day of class.

A basketball camp for middle school students will be offered emphasizing ball handling, shooting, footwork and offensive and defensive skills.

The camp will be at Farmington High School from June 29 to July 30 from 11 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday. Register at Farmington High School on June 22 from 8 a.m. to noon. The fee is \$30.

A **MAXI TRAINING** camp is offered to boys and girls from sixth through 12th grade covering ball handling, offensive and defensive skills, fundamentals and intramural competition.

Registration will be on June 22 in the Farmington High School lobby from 8

a.m. to noon. The cost is \$30. The high school boys' camp will be from 8:30-11 a.m. and the girls' camp from 9:30-11 a.m.

Boys' and girls' camp for grades six through eight will be from 11 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. on Mondays through Thursdays.

Weight training for football, a camp open to all high school students, is planned for June 23 to July 30 at North Farmington High School.

Emphasis will be on improving football skills through specific weight-training exercises and programs. Beginning programs and power training will be covered. The fee is \$30.

A sports and fitness camp will emphasize performance skills and organized exercise in track & field, soccer and football at Farmington High School from June 24-July 9 (session I) and July 13 to July 28 (session II).

This is open to all boys and girls in grades six through 11 for a \$30 fee. The registration will be on Tuesday, June 23, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. in the Farmington High School lobby.
