

Cranbrook dominates All-Area tennis team

whose team finished second behind Cranbrook at the Class B state meet.

BRAD WAYBURN, a senior and the No. 3 singles player on coach Don Brown's Cranbrook squad, had his hopes for an individual state title dashed by yet another Three Rivers snafu, Ted Tucker, in the flight finals. Wayburn finished with an excellent 23-5 record and a regional crown.

GLENN SAPERSTEIN, Cranbrook's No. 4 singles man, was unbeat until he lost in the flight finals at state to Rick Verneil of Three Rivers. The Crane senior logged 28 match victories this season.

BRAD GOODMAN, Detroit Country Day School's outstanding No. 2 singles player, lost only one of his 24 matches, that decision going to Grosse Pointe University-Liggett's Gar Knight. But the DCDS junior avenged that loss by knocking off Knight in the finals of the Class C-D state meet, 6-1, 7-6. Liggett and Country Day finished first and second in the state meet.

CARLOS MORAVEK, also a junior at Country Day, lost seven of his 24 matches at

No. 1 singles. He was regional runner-up and made the semifinals to the C-D state meet, where he lost to Kalamazoo Hackett's Todd Cohen, 7-5, 6-2.

KEN FRANK, a senior at Southfield-Lathrup, was the top singles player in the Metro Suburban Activities Association this season. Frank, a regional champion with a 15-6 record, helped coach Ed Wall's Lathrup team win the MSA title, place second in the regional and tie Andover for sixth in the Class A state meet.

SCOTT KALT, a senior and Lathrup's No. 2 singles player, had a 15-4 record. He won the regional and played well at state, finally losing in the quarterfinals to Steve Walker of Kalamazoo Loy Norrix, 6-2, 7-5.

MIKE SIMPSON, Rochester's top singles player, lost just two matches of 23, and Andover's Bagley was the culprit both times. The Rochester sophomore won the No. 1 singles title at the Waterford Regional and advanced to the second round at the state meet where Bagley was waiting. Rochester finished with an 11-3 record and a Greater Oakland Activities League crown.

ADAM GORDON, another outstanding

sophomore, helped Farmington Harrison win a Western Six League championship. Gordon had a 16-3 record playing at No. 1. He beat the defending Class B state champion, Three Rivers' Dave Klew, in the state meet, before losing to Cranbrook's Bromberg in the semifinals.

JEFF GREENBERG, who played No. 1 singles for West Bloomfield, compiled a 13-7 record. Greenberg, a senior, was regional runner-up to Rochester's Simpson. "He's been a good, solid No. 1 for us," said West Bloomfield coach Greg Kopec.

ERIC HOFLEY, a sophomore at Birmingham Brother Rice, qualified for the Class A state meet, thanks to his victory at No. 1 singles in the regional. Hofley, who made the state quarterfinals and had a 16-7 record, was called "one of the smartest players we've ever had" by his coach, Don McKercher.

Sophomore **KEITH KING** and junior **JEFF TREES** won 26 of their 29 matches playing at No. 1 doubles for Cranbrook. After winning their regional flight, the duo won the state meet with a 6-2, 4-6, 6-3 victory over Sturgis' Todd Tufts and Dave Lampe.

BRUCE HENDRICK and **JOHN SOLIK**, junior and freshman respectively, lost just one of 28 matches as Cranbrook's No. 2 doubles team. That loss came against a team from Cleveland (Ohio) University School, one of the top prep tennis teams in the nation. The Crane pair won regional and state titles.

CHARLIE MOORE and **BOB JASMER**, Cranbrook's No. 3 doubles team finished a season similar to the Crane's No. 2 team — a 28-1 record (the sole loss was to Cleveland University) and regional and state titles.
