Monica Walch takes position in county

To advance therapeutic programs for the handicapped and expand current recreational programs, the Oakland County Parks and Recreation Commission has named two individuals to its administrative staff.

Monica Walch has been appointed to the new position of therapeutic recreation supervisor for the county. Dan Stencil joins the county parks staff as recreation supervisor.

Ms. Walch acts as a consultant for the cities of Oakland County interested in forming therapeutic recreation programs in their own communities. The Parks and Recreation Commission is serving as an umbrella agency in the coordination of these programs.

"One of my goals is to see every city in Oakland County have an active therapeutic recreation program," said Ms. Walch, a resident of Farmington Hills.

She said that at present only five out of 20 cities in the county provide recreation programs for the handicapped.

Ms. Walch is also the Oakland County coach for the Cerebral Palsy Olympic Team and Oakland County liaison

for the International Year of the Disabled Person.

She previously was employed as a special activities coordinator with the city of Farmington Hills and as a part-time recreational therapist for the Oakland County Parks and Recreation Commission.

Stencil will be responsible for senior citizen programs, bike motocross (BMX) races, the tennis and court games complex, mobile recreation units and special events.

As he will have assistance from coordinators and volunteers, Stencil describes his position as an overseer. He said he wants to maximize the amount and quality of recreational programs and minimize the cost, "to provide the best programs to the public for their tax dollars," he said.

Stencil, who lives in Brighton, has previously worked for the parks as an assistant parks supervisor at Independence Oaks County Park in Clarkston and as parks helper at Springfield Oaks County Park in Davisburg.

Stencil is active in the Oakland County Parks volunteer Nordic Ski Patrol. He replaces Tom Seavey, who has gone into private business.
