

OU picks interim provost, new dean

Oakland University has a new dean and an interim provost, following board of trustee actions. The appointments fill key vacancies at the 12,000-student university.

New dean of the School of Nursing is Dr. Andrea R. Lindell, 37, of the University of New Hampshire. Her appointment is effective Aug. 1.

Dr. Keith R. Kleckner, 45, a veteran OU faculty member and administrator,

has been appointed interim provost effective July 1. Kleckner will serve while the university mounts a national search for a replacement for Frederick W. Obeir, who left to become chancellor of the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga.

Ms. Lindell is currently an associate professor and chairman of the department of nursing at the University of New Hampshire. She earned her mas-

ter's of science degree in 1972 and a doctorate in nursing science in 1975, with a specialization in psychiatric nursing, both from Catholic University.

Kleckner came to Oakland University as an associate professor of engineering in 1966 and was promoted to full professor in 1971. He was assistant dean of engineering for graduate study from 1969 to 1975 and was responsible for guiding the development of Oak-

land's first doctoral program, the interdisciplinary Ph.D. in systems engineering.

He was acting dean of graduate study in 1974-75 and assumed his present position as associate provost in 1975. He has administrative responsibility for admissions, registration and records, research services, financial aid, and community college relations.

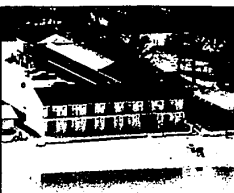

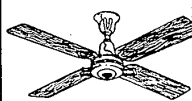

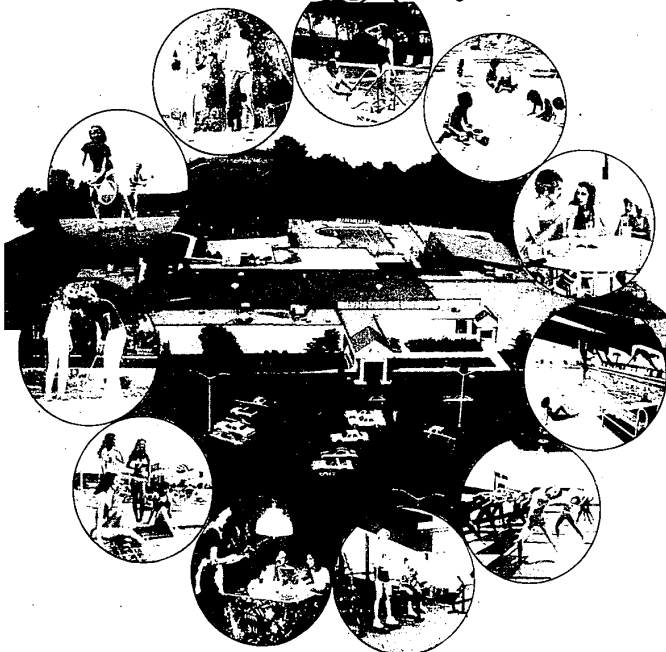
