

# Area's top trackmen gain honors

Troy and Southfield, the top two track teams in the Southeastern Michigan Association (SMA) this year, grabbed 10 of the 25 first-team spots on the 1981 Observer & Eclectic All-Area boys' track team.

In all, 13 individuals and four relay teams received first-team accolades on this year's squad, selected by a panel of five area coaches.

Dan Kenwell, West Bloomfield's shot putter, highlights the first team. Kenwell, the top shot putter in the area with a heave of 60 feet, 7 inches, was the only Oakland County thirder to win a gold medal at the Class A state meet for his first-place effort in the shot-put competition.

Ten of the area's 20 boys track schools are represented on the first team. Troy and Southfield landed five athletes each. Detroit Country Day and Avondale both had first-team relay squads, landing four members each on the first team. West Bloomfield landed two, and Farmington High, North Farmington, Southfield-Lathrup, Birmingham Seaholm and Bloomfield Hills Cranbrook had one each.

Members of the boys track panel included Bob Stark of Birmingham Brother Rice, Dick Collins of Avondale, Lee Averill of West Bloomfield, Dave Catherman of Farmington High and John Bancroft of Troy.

## INDIVIDUAL HONORS

**DAN KENWELL** — The soft-spoken West Bloomfield shot putter not only won the Class A title, but he also placed first at the Oakland County meet, the West Bloomfield Regional and the Greater Oakland Activities League (GOAL) meet — in both the shot put and discus. Kenwell, a senior, finished seventh in state-meet discus competition.

**BRADD MORSE** — Troy's Morse, a second-place performer at the Class A state meet in discus, finished with the area's best discus throw — 172-11.

Only a junior, Morse was the SMA champion and a regional champion. He placed third at the county meet.

**CRAIG KIELTY** — Farmington's Kielty is one of the most versatile athletes on the squad, although he gains honors as the top high jumper in the area. Kielty tied Gary Burns of Birmingham Brother Rice with the area's top high jump of 6-8. Kielty, however, jumped a 6-8 at the state meet to place third in this event. Kielty, a senior, was among the area's leaders in the long jump as well.

**FREEMAN DONLOE** — Southfield's Donloe, a senior, had big shoes to fill this year, replacing All-Stater Vincent Bean in the long jump. And he admirably responded with a second-place finish in this event at state. Donloe's best jump this season was 23-3. He placed second in the regional and county meets and was the SMA champion. He also ran one leg of Southfield's first-team 440-yard relay.

**JIM ROTH** — Clearly the top pole vaulter in the area (14-8), and one of the best in the state, Birmingham Seaholm's Roth battled an injury-riddled season enroute to first-team honors. No one challenged him locally this year. The next best vaulter didn't top the 13-foot mark. Roth, a senior, was the SMA champion and first in the regional, but did not compete in the county or state meets because of injuries.

**CORNELIUS EDWARDS** — Only a junior, Southfield's Edwards registered the area's fastest time in the 120-yard high hurdles — 14.7 seconds. He was the SMA champion in this event, placed second at the regionals and third at the county meet.

**JACK JOHANSSON** — Johansson, another junior, had the second best time in the 330-yard low hurdles (39.5), but received first-team honors for beating Southfield's Darryl Darden head-to-head in both the SMA meet and regional meet. Darden had the area's best low-hurdle time (39.4). Johansson,

the SMA champ, also is a member of Troy's first-team mile relay team.

**LARRY GARLINGHOUSE** — Mr. Everything for Southfield-Lathrup this season, Garlinghouse, a senior, was one of the area's top sprinters. He received first-team honors in the 100-yard dash, where his fastest time was 10.1 seconds — best in the area.

**DOUG PFAU** — Troy's Pfau, a senior, had the third best 220-yard dash time in the area behind Detroit Country Day's Geoffrey Craig and Southfield's Freeman Donloe. Both Craig and Donloe are honored in other events. Pfau, whose fastest 220 time was 22.8 seconds, also is a member of Troy's first-team mile relay squad.

**GEOFFREY CRAIG** — Craig, a versatile sprinter for Detroit Country Day, is honored at the top 440-yard runner in the area. Craig, a senior, has the area's best times in both the 220 (22.4) and the 440 (48.9). He was a Class C regional winner in the 440 and is a member of the first-team 880-yard relay crew.

**JOHN WINTERBOTTOM** — North Farmington's Winterbottom, a junior, earned his claim to fame as a regional winner in the 880-yard run. He also had the area's top time in the 880 (1:57.6) to earn first-team honors. Winterbottom placed third in the county meet, but failed to score at state.

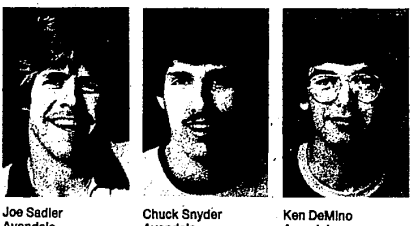

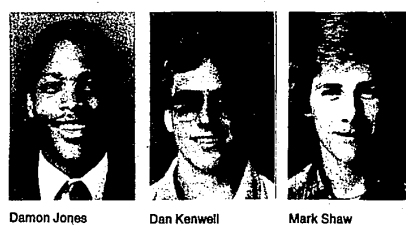
