"A pair of good kitchen scissors is a must and just as important in the kitchen as sharp knives," explained the rotund mustachicod chef. "SOME THINGS should never be chopped. Fresh dill for instance, must always be supped with scissors. If you chop it, the oil in the herb dissipates on the chopping board." Sta Szathmary also told his listeners to chill hot hands. "If you just naturally have hot hands, place a bowl of water with lee cubes, covered with plastic wrap, near your work area. "When your hands get too bot to handle the pastry, place them on top of the plastic wrap for a few seconds. This will chill them sufficiently to proceed with blending the pastry."

Food's appearance is very important to Louis Szathmary. "First we eat with our eyes" said the chef-proprietor of Chleago's Bakery restaurant. "Food must look good." Known as a "man for all seasonings," Chef Louis recently showed area cooks some of the tricks that have made him nationally famous. Capacity crowds turned out for his recent appearances at Kitchen Glamor stores in Avon Township, Farmington and Troy. Szathmary (prosounced sath-mary) selected recipes that would be appropriate for the summer season. All we form his fifth and latest book, "The Bakery Restaurant Cookbook."

Cheft's salt is used for everything except desserts at the Bakery," he added.


