

Girls gather O&E All-Area track accolades

Here are the 12 individual first-team honorees on this year's squad:

ERIKA BAUER — Rochester's Bauer, a senior, was the area's top shot putter this season with a throw of 37 feet, seven inches. She also competed in the discus and two of the Falcons' relay squads. No other shot putter in the area topped 37 feet except Bauer, although she failed to qualify for the state meet with a fourth-place finish at regionals.

SHAWN SHEPARD — The area's top discus thrower, Avondale's Shepard was the only area girl to top the 120-foot mark this season. A senior, Shepard's best throw was 120-4. She was a

NOAC champion, first at the regionals, second at county and fourth in the state Class B meet.

HOLLY HEISTERKAMP — Only a sophomore, the versatile Heisterkamp from Troy Athens earned first-team recognition as the area's top long jumper — 17-4. No other area girl jumped further than 17 feet. But Heisterkamp also competed in both the 110-yard and 220-yard hurdle events. She was a regional champion in the 110-hurdles, placed third in the regional in the 220-yard hurdles and placed second in the regional in the long jump.

EILEEN STEWARD — Steward,

Bloomfield Hills Lahser's all-around senior athlete, earned honors as the area's best high jumper. Steward, also a basketball player, jumped 5-6 to win the West Bloomfield Regional crown. Steward's teammate, Fran Kienle, was a second-team selection, matching Steward's 5-6 jump at the county meet.

KRISTI JACKSON — Southfield High had a strong girls' track team this season. And one reason for the Blue Jays' success was Jackson — the area's fastest 110-yard hurdler. Jackson's best

time in this event was 14.7 seconds.

KARLA SHEPLER — West Bloomfield's Shepler was second in the final listings to Jackson in the 110-yard hurdles, but no one topped her in the 220-yard hurdle event. Shepler, a senior, placed fourth in the Class A state meet in the 220-hurdles. She was the only area girl to break the 30-second mark. Her best time was 29.5. She won the county and regional crowns.

MOLLY ACTON — Acton, a speedy

sophomore, was the area's top sprinter this season. The Troy Athens star earned honors as a first-teamer in the 100-yard dash, although she held the area's fastest times in both the 100 (11.1) and the 220-yard dash (26.9).

CATHIE BRIDGES — Bridges, a junior at Farmington Our Lady of Mercy, finished only one-tenth of a second behind Acton in the 220-yard dash (26.0) to gain first-team honors in this event. She was a regional champion and a Catholic League All-Star in the 220-dash, as well.

SUE NASH — Troy's Nash, only a freshman, was the area's best in the 440-yard dash (60.01). She was the Southeastern Michigan Association champion in this event.

CHRIS LOOSER — Farmington High's Looser finished second to Rochester's Aimee Landry in the 880-yard listings but earned first-team status because Landry was honored in the mile run. Looser's best time this season was 2:22.3 in the 880-run. Looser, a junior, placed eighth in the state in this event, second at regionals and third at county.

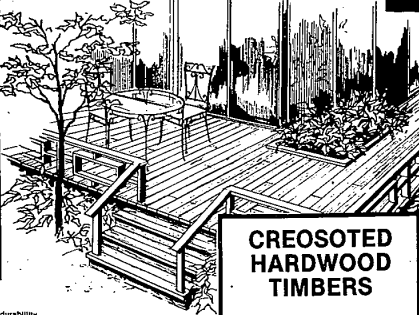
