Benefit salutes Al Kaline

Northwest General Hospital has come up with a way to beat the baseball blues — at least for one evening during the major-league baseball drought.

A \$100-per-plate "Salute to Al Kaline" dinner takes place Thursday in Detroit's Plaza Hotel.

The fifth annual dinner, which salutes persons in the field of business and athletics, supports the hospital's building fund.

tion meet with another 83 at the same Oxford Hills course.

Evans, who averaged 42.1 strokes per nine holes played, was match medalist in eight of Athens' nine duals. Athens posted a 7-2 record. Her best score this past season was a 37 on the back nine at state.

GROVES' ANN Lauer, another junior, had her team's low score in 17 of the 19 matches it played.

Her 84 at the county meet put her right behind Mallon and Evans. She finished second in the Oxford Hills Regional with an 84, and was runner-up to Evans in the MSAA meet with another 84.

Her rapid improvement is impressive. Groves coach Carl Pendraki said, "She hasn't been playing competitive golf for all that long."

Lauer failed to qualify for state be-

cause of her second-place regional finish, but Pendraki has high hopes for next season. "Next year's our year for state," the optimistic coach said.

CHERNEY, WHO HAS another year left at Marian, was low medalist in all eight of her team's dual-meet wins.

Her best multischool-meet showing was an 84 at the Brighton Invitational. She was fourth with a 56 at the county meet and shot a 90 at the regional. She didn't qualify for the state meet.

"She's a very dedicated golfer," Marian coach Suzy Breest said. "She'll work hard for what she wants."

TROY'S ROMANSKI, an all-area repeat selection like Evans and Mallon, averaged 45 strokes last season.

She's a real smoo player with great form. Troy coach Glenn Corey said, "And she's pretty consistent. Her scores never varied that much."

Lauer best nine-hole score was a 42 at

Birmingham's Springdale Golf Club in a dual meet against Birmingham Seaholm. She had to withdraw from the county meet because of a recurring elbow ailment, but she rebounded in the regional with a fifth-place finish with an 89 over Oxford Hills' par-77 layout.

Romanski was medalist in eight of Troy's 13 dual meets. Troy was 7-6 and finished 14th with 416 strokes in the state meet.

At state, Romanski and Mallon were two of the six golfers tied for third with 85s.

GIBBONS, A SOPHOMORE on coach Jim Seligren's Kingswood team, failed to qualify for state, although her regional round — an 86 at Oxford Hills for third place — was impressive.

At the Brighton Invitational, Gibbons finished fifth in a field of 56 girls with 19-over 91 at Burroughs Farms. Her 97 was good for six at the county meet.

"She should be one of the top prep

golfers in the state by the time she's a senior," Seligren said.

COACH BUNETTA, who teaches math at Mercy, guided the team to an 8-2 record and a first-place finish in the county meet with 402 strokes. Mercy tied Grand Blanc with 383 strokes for third place in the state tournament.
