THE COURTS have ruled that dis-crimination on the basis of age is ille-gal under current federal law, with some exceptions, Mrs. Poindexter said.

She said the law allows for age re-strictions when an owner occupies one of two dwellings in the same building and rents out the other. A boarding house may impose age restrictions, and so may a housing complex designated for senior citizens 50 and over. Some rental managers have imposed regulations like denying children the use of the apartment swimming pool on certain days. The courts have struck down those policies too, said Mrs. Poin-dexter.

"The big question still remaining is whether rental managers can impose age restrictions on the use of apartment facilities," she said. "The courts have not yet handed down a decision on the terms."
