The band, which was formed a year ago, is releasing its second single, "Photographs," a ballad, and "The Whole World Is Weeping," on Strawberry Records, a Detroit label. Record stores will have the new release the last week in July. Straight Up's first single, released last fall, was the double-A side "Oh, Yeah" and "For You," which got airplay on FM rock and middle-of-the-road stations. The group's first album will be entitled "Waves," the title track ballad. The band recently completed a three-month southern tour. It will play outdoor concerts in July. Straight Up is doing a tape for "American Bandstand" in August to be aired in the fall. A concert tour overseas also is planned for this fall.
