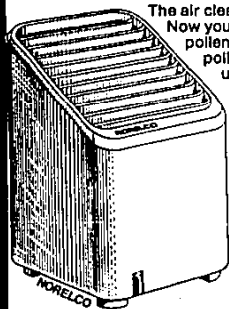

# USGA governs rules on links

The United States Golf Association and the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, Scotland, have plenty to say about how Joe Q. Golfer plays the game.

The organizations wrote the book when it comes to the rules of golf, and they "reserve the right to change the rules and interpretations regulating golf at any time."

Here are some golf rules unlikely to be found among the Sunday hacker's repertoire. All are quoted directly from the USGA's "The Rules of Golf 1981."

**CASUAL WATER** is any temporary accumulation of water which is visible before or after the player takes his stance and is not in a water hazard. Snow and ice are either casual water or loose impediments, at the option of the player.

**LOOSE IMPEDIMENTS** denotes natural objects not fixed or growing and not adhering to the ball, and includes stones not solidly embedded, leaves, twigs, branches and the like; dung, worms and insects and casts or heaps made by them.

**THE HOLE** shall be four and one-fourth inches in diameter and at least four inches deep. If a lining is used, it shall be sunk at least one inch below the putting green surface unless the nature of the soil makes it impractical to do so. Its outer diameter shall not exceed four and one-fourth inches.

**HONOR:** The side which is entitled to

play first from the teeing ground is said to have the honor.

**A RUB OF THE GREEN** (much unlike the sensation produced by a wad of dollar bills rubbing against a person's body while walking) occurs when a ball in motion is accidentally stopped or deflected by an outside agency.

**THE RULES OF THE ROYAL** and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews provide that the weight of the ball shall be not greater than 1.620 ounces avoirdupois, the size not less than 1.62 inches in diameter and the velocity not greater than 250 feet per second when measured on an apparatus approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club.

**HALVED HOLE:** A hole is halved if each side holes out in the same number of strokes. When a player has holed out and his opponent has been left with a stroke for the half, nothing that the player who has holed out can do shall deprive him of the half which he has already gained, but if the player thereafter incurs any penalty, the hole is halved.

**ASSISTANCE:** In making a stroke, a player shall not seek or accept physical assistance or protection from the elements.

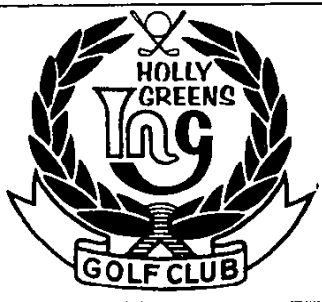
**LONG GRASS AND BUSHES:** If a ball lies in long grass, rushes, bushes, whins, heather or the like, only so much thereof shall be touched as will enable the player

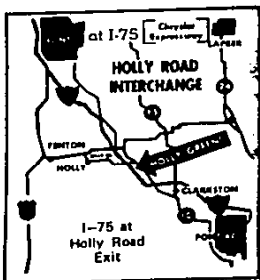
