How to use less gas on your next vacation

Even with the high price of gasoline, you can pay less for your driving vacation by using simple fuel-conservation methods, the Automotive Information

methos, the Auctionary Council said.

The Southfield-based group said there are several ways to cut gas costs on a vacation. The following are some suggestions offered by the automobile-advocacy organization.

PACKING THE CAR properly can save fuel. Try limiting the amount of luggage each person brings because extra weight robs fuel. Piling suitcases on top of the car increases wind resistance and uses more gas, so try to put all the luggage in the trunk.

Observe the 55 mph speed limit. For every five mph over 50 there is a loss of one mile to the gallon.

If you do a lot of open-road driving, the AIC said, a cruise-control option may be worthwhile, since it will maintain a steady speed, which saves fuel.

Plan driving routes ahead of time to avoid bottlenecks. Avoid driving during rush hours and other peak driving times. Try to plan meal and rest stops to coincide with heavy-traffic periods.

On long trips during the summer, start early to avoid hot weather and minimize the need for air conditioning. Use the fresh-air wents when the outside temperature is still comfortable.
