Here's one of those movies, like "West Side Storry," that manges to overlook totally the sectoconomic problems of the day in order to bring to ta, the viewing public, the best in contemporary music. At least "To Sir With Love" does it well. Sidney Politier plays the teacher who devotes himself to the youth of a London slum school. Any resemblance between them and the skinheads, mods or bother boys of the day is purely coincidental. Sury Kendall, Judy Geseon and Lula provide ample support as another teacher and students, respectively. Politier really carried the slow, though, and the music is quite good. Rating: \$3.

Speaking of music, one of the best film composers, Erich Wolfgang Korngold, carries the show in "Sea Hawk." Not even Errol Flynn is equal to the score in this Michael Cutris film that has trouble getting off the ground. Korngold did many Flynn' Warrer Brothers vehicles, including "Captain Blood" (1955). "The Prince and the Pauper" (1837). "The Adventures of Robin Hood" (1938) and "Elizabeth and Essex" (1939). "Sea Hawk" is the best of the lot for Korngold but a disappointment for Flynn Rating: \$2.60.
