# Beat goes on for Heart of Hills

Undeclared Heart of the Hills of Rochester made it four in a row with a 314-272 victory over Farmington Glen in Northwest Suburban Swim League (NSSL) action Thursday. The loss dropped Glen to 1-3.

Double winners for Heart of the Hills included Pat McNickle in the girls' 11-12-year-old age division backstroke (38.89) and butterfly (34.59); Sheri Fedak in girls' 13-14 individual medley (1:15.89) and backstroke (35.52); Dan Wery in boys' 15-17 breaststroke (32.75) and butterfly (30.25); Ann Burke in girls' 9-10 butterfly (40.50) and freestyle (33.80); Doug Cleland in boys' 15-17 backstroke (29.86) and individual medley (1:02.25); and Missy Proctor in girls' 15-17 backstroke (32.70) and individual medley (1:13.47).

Glen's double winners included Bobby Pelon in boys' 7-8 backstroke (21.99) and breaststroke (24.83); Mark Frazer in boys' 9-10 butterfly (41.06) and freestyle (38.58); Kim Pogue in girls' 15-17 butterfly (32.28) and individual medley (1:03.17); and Erin Ringold in girls' 7-8 breaststroke (26.19) and butterfly (22.55).

Pogue set a record in the 100-meter freestyle (1:03.17) for Glen.  
For Heart of the Hills, Cleland erased the 100-meter individual medley mark (1:02.25) and Jeff Zwerner shattered the 9-10 backstroke record (40.01).

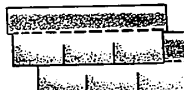

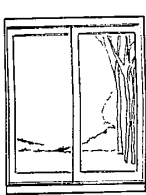

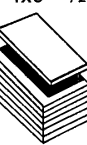
