

# King Arnie reigns at Oakland Hills

It was classic of the many Palmer "charges" which won the hearts of golf fans all over the world in the late '50s and early '60s.

Palmer bogied Nos. 1, 4 and 6, while Stone birdied No. 2 and eagled No. 5, thanks to a 170-yard seven-iron shot that rolled in the hole.

But, even though Palmer felt discouraged, he kept control of the situation — always walking in front of Casper and Stone down each fairway, as his "army" shouted words of encouragement.

"Come on, Arnie, get something going," shouted one man from the gallery at the seventh hole. "You're six down to that guy (Stone)."

"I've got to believe that he's going to make some kind of charge," whispered another fan while Palmer was putting at No. 8. Then she yelled, "Come on Arnie, you can do it!"

Arnie did it. He birdied No. 8 with a 10-foot putt and put his drive 18 feet from the flag on the 210-yard, par-3 No. 9.

"Now let's see you smile," one fan said to Palmer, as he walked down the

ninth fairway. "It's (the putt) got to drop, Arnie. It's got to drop."

It dropped.

Palmer sunk the 18-footer, while Stone bogeyed No. 7 and No. 9, cutting the lead to two.

PALMER FINALLY caught Stone at No. 12, a long 560-yard, par-5. Palmer birdied the hole with a 12-foot putt, while Stone's approach shot sailed over the green. Stone settled for bogey six and the two golfers were tied.

After they traded bogeys on Nos. 13 and 14, Palmer then sank a 40-footer on the 15th to go ahead for good.

Stone bogeyed the final three holes, and Casper, who didn't have a birdie all day, was all but finished with his disaster at 16.

Palmer, criticized by some followers as staying around too long on the tour, reaffirmed that he plays for the enjoyment of the sport.

But if there was any doubt that he could no longer compete, those doubts were put to rest on Monday.

"It's enjoyable, but I'm not just here to have fun," Palmer said. "I want to win, but I enjoy playing."
