

Police probe motorcycle accident

Preliminary investigation indicates a West Bloomfield police officer was not at fault when his patrol car collided with a motorcycle as he attempted to reach the scene of an accident last Friday morning.

The northbound lane going south on Orchard Lake Road. He was headed toward a car accident at Orchard Lake and Maple roads.

Police reports said Stein collided with the motorcycle, which allegedly also veered into the northbound lanes to skirt the southbound traffic.

"In my opinion, the motorcycleist was the cause of the accident," Clark said Tuesday. "The motorcycle ran into the right front fender of the patrol car."

The driver, John W. Geyer, 22, of West Bloomfield, was listed in good condition Tuesday with a leg injury at Providence Hospital, a hospital spokesman said.

"I TALKED TO several witnesses. The indication was the patrol car was not exceeding his emergency limits. His lights and siren were on. The short skid marks and point of impact of the accident bear it out," Clark reported.

The investigation so far shows "the officer was right in what he did, that he

drove in a prudent manner. He was legal," he reported.

Two witnesses must still be interviewed, as well as the injured motorcycleist, Clark added.

The accident occurred shortly before 10 a.m. at the Orchard Lake-Maple intersection.

The original accident to which police were responding involved a woman whose accelerator pedal stuck. There was property damage but no personal injury, according to police records.
