THREE BASIC services are provided by the center for children age 6-18.
First there is an evaluation including psychological, hearing, reading and vision tests. Then comes diagnosis of the nature of the student's learning problem. Finally, the center staff develops an individual remedial study program.
Sudents are usually referred by teachers or schools in the greater Detroit area. Sometimes, though, parents take initiative to ask help for their children, Sister Martina said.
Tutoring classes are offered throughout the school year before and after regular school hours, and on a more intensive daily basis during the summer. Costs for the program are a diagnostic fee of \$50 for testing and program hour for small group participation, \$10 an hour for individual consellar.
