

# NF-WB team wins state Babe Ruth title

The North Farmington-West Bloomfield Metro Sportabout baseball players tasted success last year when they won a Sandy Koufax state championship and advanced to the Koutax World Series in Knoxville, Tenn.

This summer many of the same boys are together again, this time as members of the NF-WB Babe Ruth (13-15 year old) tournament team. The names are the same — and so far so are the results.

NF-WB, under the direction of Carl Childress, fought back through the losers' bracket to win three-straight games and the Babe Ruth state title in recent competition held in Berkeley.

And once again Childress and his crew will head south — this time to Lexington, Ky. for the Babe Ruth national regional. NF-WB will play the Kentucky entry on Aug. 7.

Childress has high hopes for this year's team, just as he did for the 1980 Koutax squad, which was eliminated by Puerto Rico in the World Series.

"This year we're nice and balanced," he said. "We have four good pitchers. They're all consistent and they all throw hard."

"Our hitting is great, too. Our first 12 batters are all good. There are no outs on this team. Our ninth man hits .400."

NF-WB CAPTURED the state title by beating Grosse Pointe Woods-Shores, 10-4, for the third time in the tourney.

Winning pitcher Richard Goldberg raised his tournament record to 3-1, allowing seven hits, striking out five and walking three.

Bob Butler got the winners off to a fast start by cracking a two-run double in the first inning. Eric Kahkonen contributed two hits and drove in two runs for NF-WB, and Todd Krumm had three hits.

NF-WB advanced to the finals with a 12-9 win over the same Grosse Pointe Woods-Shores squad.

The winners blew a six-run lead as Grosse Pointe rapped out five hits and scored six runs in the fourth inning to tie the game. With the bases loaded and two out, NF-WB center fielder Zac Childress made a diving catch and threw back to second base to complete the double play.

Goldberg, who plays shortstop when he's not pitching, had two of NF-WB's 12 hits, and teammate John Collins had two hits and knocked in two runs. Mike Brown also had two hits for the winners.

Krumm, pitching in relief of Childress, was credited with the win.

DOWAGIAC BECAME NF-WB's first state tournament victim, 21-10, as the winners pounded out 20 hits.

Childress pitched a three-inning, struck out five and walked none in the next outing, a 5-1 win over host Berkeley.

Then came NF-WB's only setback. Grosse Pointe Woods-Shores, trailing by a run going into the seventh inning, scored two runs after two were out to win, 3-2.

Grosse Pointe pitcher John Menzo was outstanding, allowing five hits and striking out nine.

Dropping to the losers' bracket, NF-WB rebounded with a 13-5 victory over Lansing.

Winning pitcher Todd Williams started and worked five innings. Kahkonen finished up. John Connor and Scott Roman each had two hits and two RBIs.

# Local bowlers shine at international meet
