In the Detroit area, a check of 100 stations shows no-lead averaging \$1.453 per gallon (38.5 cents per liter), down 0.1 cent from last week.
Prices run from \$1.267 to \$1.579 (34 to 44.3 cents per litter), Regular av-

erages \$1.405 per gallon (37.1 cents per liter), 0.4 cent lower. It is priced from \$1.238 to \$1.629 (32.7 to 43 cents per liter). Detroit-area self-serve stations sell no-lead at an average \$1.365 per gallon (3.9. cents per liter), off 0.2 cent and 10.1 cents below the regional full-serve price. Self-serve regular averages \$1.259 per gallon (3.5. cents per liter), unchanged from last week and 13.4 cents below the regional serverage.


