

Price of gas falls after rise

The average cost of all gasoline grades in Michigan fell by up to 0.4 cent per gallon after two straight weeks of slight price rises for some fuels, according to the Automobile Club of Michigan.

Auto Club's weekly "fuel gauge" survey of 300 major-brand stations along main travel routes shows no-lead gasoline down 0.2 cent from last week to an average \$1.456 per gallon (34.4 cents per liter). It ranges from \$1.366 to \$1.619 (34.5 to 42.7 cents per liter).

Regular at those stations averages \$1.491 per gallon (37 cents per liter), 0.3 cent below last week.

Prices range from \$1.249 to \$1.569 (33 to 41.1 cents per liter).

At self-serve stations checked, no-lead gasoline averages \$1.384 per gallon (35.5 cents per liter), down 0.3 cent and 7.2 cents below the statewide full-serve cost. Self-serve regular averages \$1.316 per gallon (34.7 cents per liter), down 0.2 cent and 8.5 cents below the statewide cost.

In the Detroit area, a check of 100 stations shows no-lead averaging \$1.463 per gallon (38.6 cents per liter), down 0.1 cent from last week. Prices run from \$1.287 to \$1.679 (34 to 44.3 cents per liter). Regular av-

erages \$1.405 per gallon (37.1 cents per liter), 0.4 cent lower. It is priced from \$1.238 to \$1.629 (32.7 to 43 cents per liter).

Detroit-area self-serve stations sell no-lead at an average \$1.362 per gallon (35.9 cents per liter), off 0.2 cent and 10.1 cents below the regional full-serve price. Self-serve regular averages \$1.269 per gallon (33.5 cents per liter), unchanged from last week and 13.6 cents below the regional average.

At Detroit-area independent dealers, the average cost of both no-lead and regular gasoline fell 0.1 cent this week. No-lead averages \$1.321

per gallon (34.9 cents per liter), ranging from \$1.289 to \$1.349 (34 to 35.6 cents per liter). Regular averages \$1.255 per gallon (33.1 cents per liter), with a low of \$1.239 and a high of \$1.279 (32.7 to 33.8 cents per liter).

Diesel fuel in metropolitan Detroit averages \$1.328 per gallon (35 cents per liter), down 0.9 cent from last week. The price range is from \$1.289 to \$1.419 (34 to 37.4 cents per liter). Elsewhere in the state, diesel averages \$1.367 per gallon (36.1 cents per liter), up 0.1 cent. The price spread is from \$1.259 to \$1.54 (33.2 to 40.6 cents per liter).

For the 23rd straight week, all stations checked had more gasoline than they could sell.

Auto Club's survey found that along major highways, all stations checked are open daylight hours Monday through Friday, 99 percent Saturday and 78 percent Sunday. After 9 p.m., 45 percent are open weekdays, 48 percent Saturday and 38 percent Sunday. An average 11 percent are open past midnight daily.

In the Detroit area, all stations checked are open daylight hours weekdays, 97 percent Saturday and 69 percent Sunday.

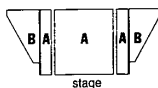
