Omnicom's parent, Capital Cities, admitted it had had a business license revoked in the case of Cablecom General, Inc. prior to its acquisition. The company admitted the Kansass City Star had lost a lawsuit with independent contreacters over newspaper distribution rights. Capital Cities admitted a National Labor Relations violation at the Oakland Press and disclosed a pending case filed in Philadelphia in 1978 against the company and other network affiliates, alleging that the station failed to fulfill its obligation to New Jersey audiences.

IT IS DIFFICULT to com rates proposed by the three bidders be-cause, while all three offer three levels or tiers of service, the offerings are dif-ferent in each. Metrovision offers a minimum service option for \$2.95 per month which includes all local TV stations plus a government access channel, a religious station and a Windsor station.

The cheapest package available in the Omnicom offer would cost a customer \$9.35 monthly but it would include the Home Theater Network at no

extra cost and WOH, a New York sta-tion.

The cheapest service available from United-Nederlander would cost the subscriber \$4.95 per month. Home Box Office (HBO), the most popular pay TV option, costs subscribers \$7.50 with United Cable and Metro Vision and \$8.95 with Omnicom.
