Concerts preview Montreux Detroit

More than 2,800 jazz enthusiasts attended the second annual "Go 4 Jazz" concert series sponsored by Channel 4. The three free concerts held recently at Detroit and suburban locations promoted this year's Montreux Detroit International Jazz Festival.

WDIV vice-president and general manager Amy McCombs said the concerts were part of the station's effort to build support for the internationally acclaimed gathering of jazz greats scheduled for Wednesday through Sept. 7 at various Detroit locations.
