Monday was the last day on the job for Mrs. Quilley who is retiring. She has sold the restaurant at a significant profit over the paltry \$1,500 she acquired it for \$\$Sot\$ 1, \$1944, but she declined to reveal the purchase price. But the continuing success of the restaurant is very important to her, and the new owner has invited her to visit regularly and "eat as much as I like."

She plans to accept the invitation from time to time, not because she eats a lot, which is apparent by her thin frame but because "Twe made many close friends while I've had the restaurant and I want to wist them on occasion." Mrs. Quinley said she considers all of her customers friends and the feeling obviously is mutual, evidenced by a standing room crowf for the usual Sunday breakfast that doubled as a farewell party for the long-time restaurateur and friend.
