

Lew Ayres shows 'Altars of World'

Michigan Council for the Humanities and major Detroit churches join Meadow Brook Hall (Oakland University near Rochester) in presenting actor Lew Ayres, in person, with his award-winning film "Altars of the World."

"ALTARS OF THE WORLD" won the Golden Globe Award for Best Documentary of 1976 and the Film Advisory Board's Award of Excellence.

Lew Ayres, best known internationally for his movie, TV and radio acting career, has spent a lifetime of study and 20 years of filming in locations all over the world to make this documentary.

Religions included in the film are Hinduism, Theravada Buddhism, Mahayana Buddhism, Shinto, Jainism, Islam, Sikhism, Zoroastrianism, Judaism and Christianity. The film records religious rites, temples and place of pilgrimage, as well as interviews with religious leaders and meditative disciples.
