


In fashion

He's ambitious, enjoys freedom

Recently I had the opportunity to hear Dr. Wayne Dyer tape an hour-long special for Channel 56. The psychologist, formerly O Betroit, is author of several best sellers, the latest "The Sky's the Limit." That was also the title of the special be shown nationwide in late November or early De-

After taping, Dr. Dyer wrote a quick sample of s novel writing for me to share with my reading

The first glance reveals an upward slant of the writing lines which suggest optimism and ambition This is a man who lives with sanguine expectation.

All capital letters are large and unpretentious, except on his surname, which I will discuss separately. Capitals such as these relate to inner confidence of self and his abilities. The capital D in Dyer moders the surname almost tillegible, suggesting his desire for anonymity. Doesn't this seem reasonable for a man who is so well known and sought

His upper zone letters are more prominent than the lower zone letters. This tells us that his interest in the abstract ares of life. Philosophy, syschology, religion or any of the other intangibles is more pro-nounced then his interest in the material and physi-cal aspects of life. Interest in the tangibles is re-

The large size of his letters indicates his orienta-tion to interpersonal relationships and involvement. This man also injoys freedom to move about and

would not like to be confined to small quarters.

This quick handwriting with its shortcuts reveals speed of thought. Little wonder that he could captivate his audience for an entire hour with neither notes nor hesitation.




