

We need leaders, not candle lighting

Events in Poland scream for response and our president asks us to light a candle. Light is an important symbol and candles are beautiful, but I have never been convinced anyone is saved by wax.

There are hints in the news that various governments are working hard behind the scenes. How much more helpful it would have been if our president had assured us he was in constant touch with diplomats and staying close to his phone to be personally involved.

It is quite clear that the Polish people have a problem. Our problem is similar but not so obvious. The problem is lack of trust in one's own government. Lighting a candle is an admission that we are not in personal contact. We feel powerless and our faith in our own government diminishes.

Candlelighting is not an ideological struggle which will be decided by mass opinion. Widespread support is important but the truth is that we are

in a power struggle. The enemy is barbarism not belief.

BARBARISM is a universal threat. The desire to control by brute force is while seemingly unaware of the people who are the real reason for the confrontation. Government exists for people and we need assurance that our leaders are involved in crisis so world community is not destroyed.

Violence and terrorism are the tools of barbarians. When we give up on the ability of government of govern we attack. Barbarians caused the dark ages

helping ourselves. The weapons are in cathedrals and museums, in concert halls and auditoriums. Flowers and picket fences tamed the American frontier so opera houses could be built and morals lifted by cultivated consciences.


THE ISSUE is people and the weapons are personal. People are known one by one, not in letters. We need to trust our government to enlist skilled diplomats who give their total personal power to pursuing peace. We need to know civilizing forces are being used in crisis.

The popular style these days is to increase military spending. This is to join terrorists by trusting those who light fuses while we light candles. The need is leaders who are personally involved so our government is fighting for dignity and decency both at home and abroad.


