HERE IS Selby's assessment of current supply sources:

Guil of Merice gas which used to sell for \$2.40 per thousand cubic teet (mof) has been bid up to \$8.34, and other supplies are going of \$4.90 med.

• Mexico — has large gas reserves but refuses to sell significant amounts to this country because it is using gas to replace oil in its industry, and selling oil instead.


