

Use free evening for learning new or relearning old

The Ten Mile Community School has launched another season of evening classes with some new choices and old favorites.

Classes begin the week of Jan. 18. Interested persons may register either by mail or in person at the Ten Mile School, 32789 Ten Mile, Farmington 48024.

Registration is from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. or from 7-9 p.m. Monday through Thursday. Fees are payable at the time of registration. Mail registrants should plan on attending the class at the first meeting. A \$2 registration fee will be deducted in the case of withdrawal.

No further notification will be given. Refunds will be granted when classes are cancelled. All other requests must be made to the Community Education Office before the second class meeting. A \$2 registration fee will be deducted in the case of withdrawal.

Persons 60 years and older are eligible for one free registration except in limited enrollment classes. Identification from the school must be obtained prior to registration.

Following is a list of the evening classes, their times and tuition.

Classes are eight weeks unless otherwise indicated.

GROUND SCHOOL FOR PRIVATE PILOT RATING — (15 weeks) Wednesday, 7-10 p.m. Room 7. \$40. Course covers the fundamentals of aircraft structure, aerodynamics, meteorology, pilotage, and radio navigation. Includes preparation for Private Pilot FAA written examination. Upon successful completion of course, students will be

awarded certificate to meet FAA requirements.

PHOTOGRAPHY I — (six weeks) Wednesday, 7-9 p.m. Room 8. \$20. An introductory course on fundamentals of the camera, exposure, focusing, motion, depth of field, lenses and filters. Course will include two field trips.

UPHOLSTERY — (Farmington High) Thursday, 6:30-9:30 p.m. Base. \$35. Brighten and modernize your home by learning and putting into use the basic fundamentals of upholstery. Group demonstration and individual instruction. Tools and a large selection of materials can be purchased. Bring your chair the first night class. Limited enrollment.

BRIDGE, BEGINNERS — Tuesday, 7-9:30 p.m. Room 4. \$20. Covers hand counting, evaluation and bidding. Playing of hands interspersed with instruction to aid in gaining playing experience.

BRIDGE, INTERMEDIATE — Monday, 7-9:30 p.m. Room 4. \$20. Course in play of specially prepared hands for those who have had beginners' course and/or playing experience. Play preceded by rapid review of bidding fundamentals, lead, play, defense instruction and instruction of certain bidding conventions.

SPEED READING & COMPREHENSION SKILLS — (Farmington High) Wednesday, 7-9 p.m. Room 212B. \$20. Designed to help the individual improve his reading rate, comprehension, vocabulary and critical

thinking. Class discussion, practice with visual aids, reading selections with comprehension checks.
