

Oakway joins dancers for performance

In its third concert of the 1982 season Oakway Symphony Orchestra will be joined by the Harbinger Dance Company. They will perform works by Copland, Ravel and Mozart in a Sunday, 3 p.m. performance Jan. 24 at Harrison High School (12 Mile, west of Middlebelt).

Director Francesco Di Blasi and the orchestra will open the afternoon program with Barber's "Essay for Orchestra" and Tebalovsky's "Theme and Variations," featuring a violin solo by Emily Kutter Astin.

After the intermission three dance performances will follow. The first, entitled "Ritual," done to Copland's "Quiet City," will highlight Barbara Grover (English horn) and Brian Moon (trumpet). Choreography for the dance is by Harbinger director, Lisa Nowak (costumes by Barbara Mostachin; lighting by Paul Andreocovich) and feature dancers Thomas Morrell and Kitty Skillman. Ravel's "Gaspard de la Nuit - Le Gibet" is the subject of the second piece, entitled "Three Figures," and featuring dancers Susan Clayton, Claudia Laslie and Rip Parker.

The closing selection, "Night Dances," performed to Mozart's "Divertimento No. 1" highlights dancers Susan Clayton, Gayle Stern Eubanks, Cheryl Heinrich, Claudia Laslie, Peggy Levine, Thomas Morrell, Rip Parker, Kitty Skillman and Terry Wilson.

Michigan's first professional dance company, Harbinger, celebrating their 10th anniversary, is under the artistic direction of Lisa Nowak. A student of modern dance, ballet and dance composition at Juilliard, Ms. Nowak took her bachelor's in dance at Adelphi.

Ms. Nowak was awarded a grant from the Polish government to study ballet and teach dance in Warsaw. On her return to the United States she founded Harbinger.


