

# Emily will announce Hawaii trip winner

Emily Gail will appear on the Hunters Square/Tally Hall Center Stage on Sunday, Feb. 21 at 1 p.m. to personally recall how she endured and finished in the World Triathlon competition in Hawaii on Feb. 6.

In addition, the person who was the closest in guessing Emily's finishing time in the triathlon will be announced and will win an American Airlines trip to Hawaii and one week at the Holiday Inn Waikiki courtesy of Hamilton-Miller-Hudson & Fayne Travel Corp. The entry contest was held through noon on Feb. 6 at Hunters Square/Tally Hall on Orchard Lake Road and Fourteen Mile Road, Farmington Hills.

Farmington Hills Police Chief John Nichols and Capt. Russ Conway personally escorted the official entry form vaults to police headquarters for safe keeping until Emily returns from Hawaii.

The triathlon is the premiere individual endurance event of the world. It consists of a 2.4-mile open ocean swim, a 112-mile bike race over lava rock fields and a 26.2-mile marathon run.

All three events are performed consecutively in one day by the world's most elite athletes. The triathlon is considered by some to be the ultimate human challenge.

The race was held in Kailua-Kona on the big island of Hawaii. Emily finished the grueling three-event race last year in 18 hours, 6 minutes, 24 seconds.

Sports Illustrated ran a feature article in 1979 on the second triathlon where 15 competitors (including the first female entrant) participated and 12 finished. In 1980, ABC's Wide World of Sports covered the event, which by that time, had grown to include 108 contestants, 94 of whom completed the race.

Since The Wide World of Sports program was televised, the triathlon has suddenly mushroomed to more than 600 entrants and more than 2,000 requests for applications. Triathlons are now being held all over the world. ABC's Wide World of Sports has plans to broadcast the 1982 triathlon sometime in March.
