Cold weather and cold fingers keeps Ford hotline buzzing

During the recent week with below zero level temperatures, the Frostbite Hotline at the Henry Ford Hospital logged more than 3,000 calls.

The three-minute taped telephone message tells callers what to do if they suspect they might have frostbite.

The number to call is 876-7100 and it will continue to run 24 hours per day until the cold weather conditions ease.

Dr. Anil Mody, physician in charge of the emergency room at the Henry Ford West Bloomfield Center, says it's important to be aware of frostbite symptoms, especially during cold weather.

These symptoms include:

- A painful, cold sensation.
- Burning or tingling.
- Numbness, which indicated that

tissue damage is progressing.

- Redness of the skin followed by a white or blanched look.

If frostbite is suspected, initial treatment should include:

- Rapidly and completely rewarming the affected areas of the body, but only once.

- Covering the exposed areas with warm clothing and a warm part of your body. For example, warm your feet or ears with your hands.

- Immersing the affected area in warm water (105-110 degrees) for 15-20 minutes. Again, rewarm the affected area only once.

"It's VERY important that you rewarm a frozen area completely and

rapidly only once," says Mody. "You must not allow a rewarmed area to get cold again or refreeze. If this is likely to happen before you arrive at a hospital or your doctor's office, initial rewarming should be withheld."

Mody also offers these suggestions for preventing frostbite:

- Wear several layers of clothing, rather than just one heavy coat or other heavy outer garment.

- Wear two pairs of gloves, rather than just one pair.

- If any part of your clothing gets wet, change it immediately.
