IF YOU WANT TO GET ACTIVE in your community, how about a run at being a school board trustee? All you have to do is go over to the Farmington Public Schools administrative building, 32500 Shawwassee and pick up petitions. Two seats will be open for the June 14 election. Deadline for nominating petition filing is April 12 at 4 p.m. Candidates must acquire names of 20 registered voters on the nominating petitions. The two-year term terms are from July 1, 1982 to June 30, 1985. To be eligible a candidate must be a registered voter and qualified school elector. Property ownership is unnecessary. Administrative assistant Scott Bacon is available to assist candidates with information about filing and campaign finance laws.

SENIOR CITIZEN CENTERS and apartment complexes are on the list of camera locations for March for the Oakland County Senior Citizen Discount Program. More locations are being sought by program organizers. Persons who would like to have their business used as a camera location may telephone 558-5171. Seniors have their photographs taken at the sites and laminated into plastic identification cards. These cards will enable seniors in Oakland County to take advantage of discounts offered by local merchants ranging from 4 to 30 percent. Discounts are offered on a variety of items such as automobile parts, roofing, hair care, prescription drugs and eyeglasses. A directory of participating merchants is now available and may be purchased for 65 cents at the camera locations and senior citizen centers. Persons

who wish to order the directory by mail should send a check for \$1.20 to the Oakland-Livingston Human Service Agency, 198 Oakland Ave., Pontiac 48058. To participate a senior citizen must be 60 years old. Nearby locations for obtaining an I.D. card are March 15 at the West Bloomfield Parks and Recreation and Fire Station at Greer and Hiller from noon to 2 p.m. On March 16 at Twelve-Oaks Mall, I-96 and Novi, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. On March 19 the Farmington Senior Center at Mercy Center, 28800 11 Mile, will be open from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

STAMP COLLECTORS who thought they missed out on the Super Bowl can now have a sigh of relief. The U.S. Postal Service has announced that a handstamp philatelic cancellation was authorized for use at Super Bowl XVI on January 24. Because the availability of the cancellation wasn't announced in advance, the Postal Service will make available embossed stamped envelopes which were cancelled with the Jan. 24 cancellation. The envelopes cost 24 cents and may be ordered from Super Bowl Cancellations, Postmaster, Pontiac 48053. A stamped, self-addressed envelope should accompany each order. Orders will be filled as long as the supply of envelopes lasts.

The American Lung Association is offering a self-help manual that teaches former smokers to learn about their own personal triggers to smoke and to cope with them.
