# Area girls' gym clubs shine

Two local gymnastics clubs, the Bloomfield Hills Acroaerobics and the Farmington Gymnastics Center, were well represented last weekend at the Class 1 United States Gymnastics Federation girls' state meet at the Farmington Gymnastics Center.

The meet, which attracted 41 girls from 11 clubs from across Michigan, offered competition in three age divisions — children's, 9-11 years of age; junior, 12-14; and senior, 15 and over.

In the children's division, the top three all-arounders were Acroaerobics' Heidi Brady (69.35 total score), Mary Beth Susak (69.15) and Ruth Aguayo (67.30).

Jill Stuart, another Acroaerobics, produced a total score of 73.75 to grab top all-around honors in the junior division. Kristin LaFontaine of the Farmington, Gymnastics Center was second (71.6), and Acroaerobics' Peggy McMaster was third (71.4).

These funds have been authorized by the Department of Housing and Urban Development under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 and 1977, as amended.
