

Town Hall Roster All Male in '70-71

A newspaper columnist, a cartoonist, a doctor who has gained fame through his books and a pianist with an extra sense will be the speakers in the 1970-71 Livonia Town Hall Series.

Sponsor of the program, the Livonia chapters of the American Field Service, have announced the speakers and the dates for next year's series.

SPEAKERS will be:

Haim Ginott, associate professor in the graduate department of psychology at New York University, will speak Oct. 21. Dr. Ginott is the author of "Between Parent and

Child" and the newly published "Between Parent and Teenager."

Syndicated newspaper columnist, Earl Wilson, will speak Nov. 21. His column about show business and theatrical personalities appears several times a week.

The creator of the famed Willie and Joe characters of World War II, Bill Mauldin, is the Jan. 20 speaker. The cartoonist won the Pulitzer Prize in 1945 for his portrayal of the fate of the ordinary foot soldier and won a second prize in 1959 for a cartoon on the fate of Russian poet Boris Pasternak.

Final speaker in the series will be Kreskin who will speak March 17. Since the age of five, Kreskin has been playing the piano and by the age of 12 he could hypnotize. Today he is the foremost practitioner of extrasensory perception and has also perfected the science of "Psychosonics," sound of mind.

TICKETS FOR the series are now available at \$10 with a special patron rate of \$30 and \$15 sponsor tickets also offered.

All of the programs begin at 10:30 a.m. in the Terrace Theater, 30400 Plymouth Road, Livonia. The programs are traditionally followed by a celebrity luncheon which allows the women of the audience to question the speaker.

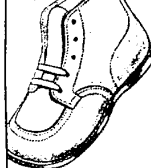
