'Victor/Victoria' mixes the sexes with broad humor

Homosexuality has not only emerged from the closet but from the film can. It suddenly has become a popular subject for movies. Julie Andrews plays Victoria, a classically trained singer who is down on her luck, like most everyone else in the '30s. She meets Toddy (Robert Reston), a hornosexual entertainer who also is unemployed, and he devises a plan to make her a show-biz sensation.

Before you can say "voila," she becomes Victor, a female impersonator. Victor is a sensation. He wows audiences with his ob-sobelievable female impersonation. And what a voice! He shatters
glass as he his E-flat.

It's the hig time and hig bucks for Victor and Toddy, but there
are complications, such as a very restricted social life. A major
complication is a visiting American nightclub owner, King Marchan (James Garner). He comes to the opening of Victoria's
nightclub act and falls for her (unaware that the act is supposedly
that of a female impersonator, only to discover at the end of the
act that Victoria is fusposedly Victor.
Victoria also falls for him. But what's a girl to do when, in order
to keep eating, she has to keep pretending she is a boy so she can
keep pretending to impersonate a gird. He kind of jokes that abound
in this movie. It doesn't, however, tell all. Such as how good Robert
Preston is as Toddy or how good the supporting cast is generally.

Alex Karras is another actor in a supporting role — he plays Marchan's bodyguard "Squash" — who contributes a lot with a subdued performance. It is a welcome, low-key contrast to Norma, the platimum blonde floozie played by Lesley Ann Warren.

Warren seems to have drawn her character from Judy Holliday with a little of Marilyn Monroe thrown in for good measure. In this case, the whole is decidedly less than the sum of its parts. Warren works too hard at being funny and ends up being loud and abrasive. James Garner doesn't fare much better in his role. He just sits around with a perpetual raised eyebrow and quizzieal expression. There is more chemistry between Andrews and Preston than between her and Garner.

The musical numbers are lavish, but one or two could have been cut without loss. And, it must Svitcor and Victoria. Her singing is bright and crisp, the movie is filled with pert observations about sexual identity, and it is all done with a lot of wit and warnth.


